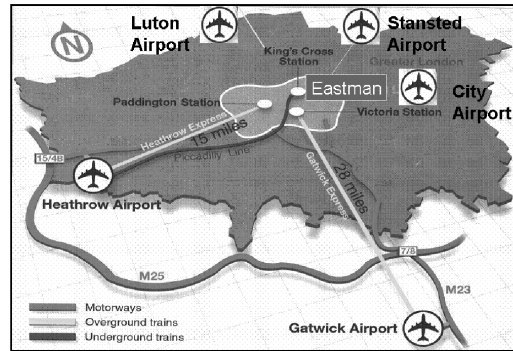


## CONFERENCE VENUE: THE EASTMAN DENTAL HOSPITAL

The Eastman is located within easy walking distance of the best rail links in Britain, with 6 tube lines and 4 major rail stations close by.



### Rail

Kings Cross, Kings Cross First Capital Connect (formerly Thameslink), St Pancras and Euston railway stations are within 10 to 15 minutes' walk.

### Underground

The Eastman lies approximately seven minutes walk from Russell Square (Piccadilly Line) Kings Cross (Northern, Piccadilly, Circle, Metropolitan and Victoria lines), and slightly further from Chancery Lane (Central line) stations.

### Bus

Numbers 17, 45 and 46 (Hopper) all stop outside the hospital and can be caught at either Kings Cross or Chancery Lane.

### Air

**Gatwick:** Gatwick Express train from Victoria station or First Capital Connect train from King's Cross Thameslink railway station.

**London City:** Central Line to Bank station and take the Docklands Light Railway direct to London City Airport.

**London Heathrow Airport:** Kings Cross St. Pancras Underground Station (Piccadilly line) or Circle or Hammersmith lines to Paddington (Mainline Station for Heathrow check-in, or Heathrow Express or Heathrow Connect services to the airport).

**London Luton:** First Capital Connect train from King's Cross Thameslink railway station.

**Stansted:** Stansted Express train from Liverpool Street or Tottenham Hale stations.

### Parking

During the week parking in the vicinity is metered and is limited to a two hour stay. Public car parking (National Car Parks) is nearby in Brunswick Square (020 7278 9792).
