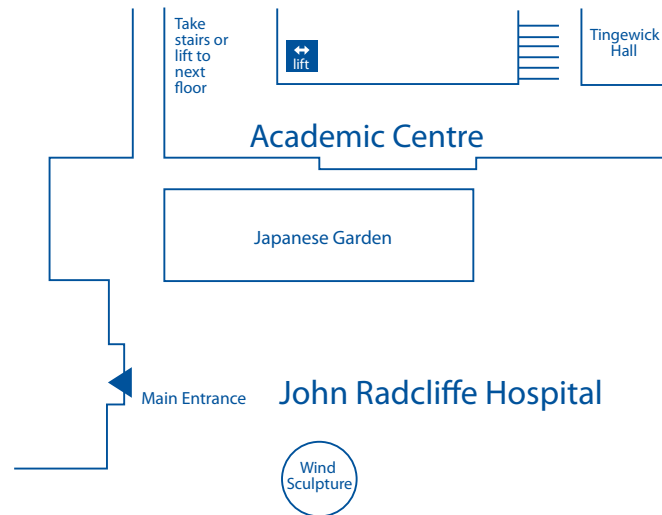
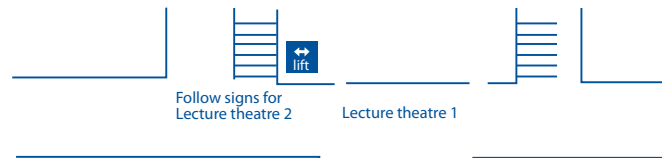

The incidence of oral cancer has increased significantly over the last 20 years. The type of person presenting with oral cancer has also altered. Traditionally heavy smoking and drinking spirits were considered the predominating predisposing causes. However, although this is still an important consideration, there is a wider and much younger group of people presenting with symptoms without any obvious predisposing factors. This conference aims to highlight the diagnoses and successful treatment management when the appropriate referral is made.
