Educational Challenges and Clinical Conundrums - The Bigger Picture

The conference will explore the educational challenges in providing specialty training in Special Care Dentistry and in developing the dental team with the requisite knowledge, skills and training to provide holistic oral health care for special care patients. Inequalities in dental education will be considered enabling deeper understanding within a global context. An update on restorative options for special care patients will end the morning session.

The afternoon will address the challenges of providing care for patients with latex allergy with practical solutions for this increasing problem. Evidence suggests there is an increasing demand for bariatric dentistry and the NICE Obesity guidelines will inform on how we can meet this challenge. The day will end with Members papers and a number of posters will be on display. The BSDH AGM will follow the scientific meeting.
