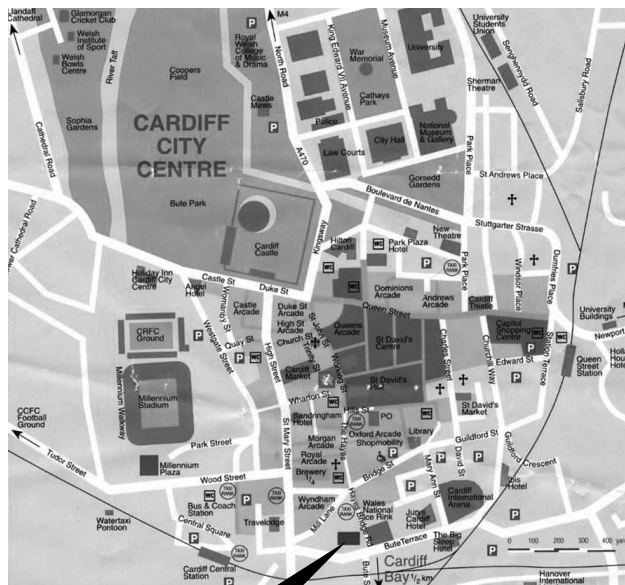

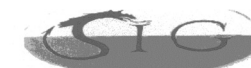

Neurodisability – Nature to Nurture

The conference will explore the subject of neurodisability from inherited movement disorders (using Huntington's disease to illustrate oral health issues), to mechanisms of bulbar function in health and acquired neurological disease. Potential barriers to achieving oral health care for patients with multiple sclerosis will be explored by a MS Clinical Nurse Specialist providing practical solutions in management.

Oral health input into a multi-disciplinary Huntington's disease clinic will inform service provision, including use of information leaflets developed for service users and carers. Quality of life issues and timely use of advanced restorative interventions will be explored; whilst, practical advice from experts in rehabilitation of oral health care for patients with neurological impairment and lip trauma will be delivered through an interactive question and answer session.

The BSDH Domiciliary guidelines will be launched at the conference.
