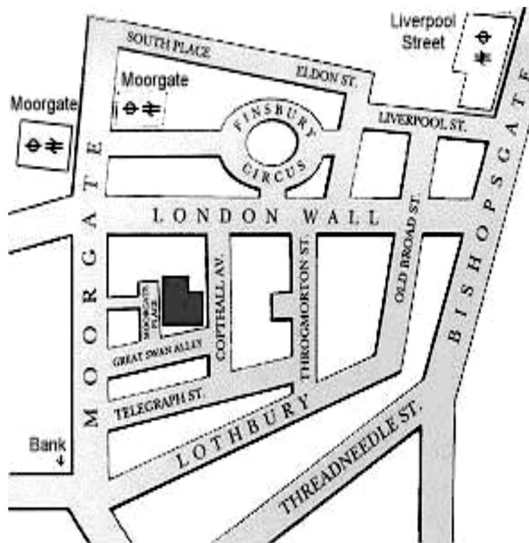
The nearest mainline station is Liverpool Street-
