Lisa works nationally as an Independent Occupational Therapist and training facilitator to assist anyone involved with people who have Autism Spectrum Conditions, including Asperger Syndrome in understanding the diagnosis, the uniqueness of these individuals and ideas of how to work with them successfully.

Course Content

The study day will consider the field of Autism, including Asperger Syndrome, from experiential, theoretical and practical perspectives. It will put forward an understanding of why people do what they do and by understanding this how we can work with them in a different way. It will offer participants, in whatever role they have, the opportunity to consider ideas of how to adapt their work and practice with an open mind, some simple ideas and limited expenditure.

Learning Objectives

By the end of the event participants will be able to:

- Describe the key traits of patients who have Autistic Spectrum Disease (ASC)
- Have an appreciation of how patients with Autism view and experience the world
- Describe ways in which you could adapt the way in which you work and your working environment to make patients with autism more relaxed
- Develop an Action Plan of changes which could be made to accommodate patients with autism.
