**DIPLOMA IN SPECIAL CARE DENTISTRY STUDY DAY**

**THURSDAY 17 MARCH 2011**

A key requirement of post graduate learning is optimising the educational interaction between the student and their clinical supervisor. This course specifically addresses the practicalities of this with Masterclasses for both mentee's and mentors providing a framework for a mutually beneficial educational compact.

To complement this, the morning session of the study day will provide an update on the key areas of clinical practice relevant to Special Care Dentistry. The afternoon is devoted to the separate Masterclasses for mentees and mentors.

The Masterclass for trainers, mentors and supervisors will give practical support to enhance the learning process with their trainee. In addition a pragmatic approach to dealing with poor performance and giving constructive feedback will be addressed by acknowledged experts in the field.

The Masterclass for trainees, mentees and postgraduate students will provide an opportunity for participants to gain experience of a simulated clinical examination and viva practice under examination conditions. This session will also provide support in writing case presentations.

At the conclusion of the day attendees will have a specific framework that will assist mentors and mentees to maximise both their education and training programmes and their preparation for future examinations. In addition, they will have enhanced their knowledge of the latest updates in Special Care Dentistry.

This course will be of interest to candidates who are preparing for the Diploma in Special Care Dentistry examination and their mentors, specialist trainees in Special Care Dentistry and their trainers and postgraduates students undertaking a course in Special Care Dentistry and their supervisors.

**Learning outcomes**

Participants will:

- Be updated of the latest developments in Special Care Dentistry;
- Trainers, mentors and supervisors will be appraised of the key elements of adult learning;
- Appreciate the challenges of a poorly performing trainee and develop a pragmatic approach to deal with this colleague;
- Understand the importance of providing constructive feedback and have developed strategies to maximise this process;
- Trainees, mentees and postgraduate students will have experience of a simulated clinical examination and have viva practice under examination conditions. They will also have received feedback on their performance;
- Improved their understanding of the key skills required in preparing written case presentations
