

## Travel Bursary

An Award of up to **£500** is available to individual members of BSDH to assist with the costs of attending the biennial congress of the [International Association of Disability and Oral Health](#) in order to make a scientific presentation.

Applicants for an award must be the principal author and should submit the abstract for their paper and their proposed expenditure, for consideration by the Awards Committee, after they have been informed by the IADH Congress organising committee that their abstract has been accepted. The successful applicant will only receive the award when proof of acceptance of the abstract by IADH congress is provided to the awards committee

The abstract should be submitted in an electronic format and sent as a '.doc' format consistent with Microsoft word 6.0 (Office 2000), or as an '.rtf' file as per the submission guidelines below
